Learning Objectives:

Produce a presentation that gives a detailed criminal profile for a convicted murder

Success Criteria:

Explanation of task.

You are working with the police as a criminal profiler. You must compile a profile of the killer and look at forensic evidence used to catch the murderer.

You can choose any murderer but try to find lesser known criminals.

You must include:

- 1. Details of the crime when, where, who was the victim and who was the criminal.
- 2. History of the criminal involved childhood (could this have led to the crimes committed)
- 3. What crimes took place?
- 4. What evidence was there that tied the criminal to the crime? Forensic evidence is important here.
- 5. How were they caught?
- 6. What happened to them sentence ...
- 7. Did this crime bring about any political changes?
