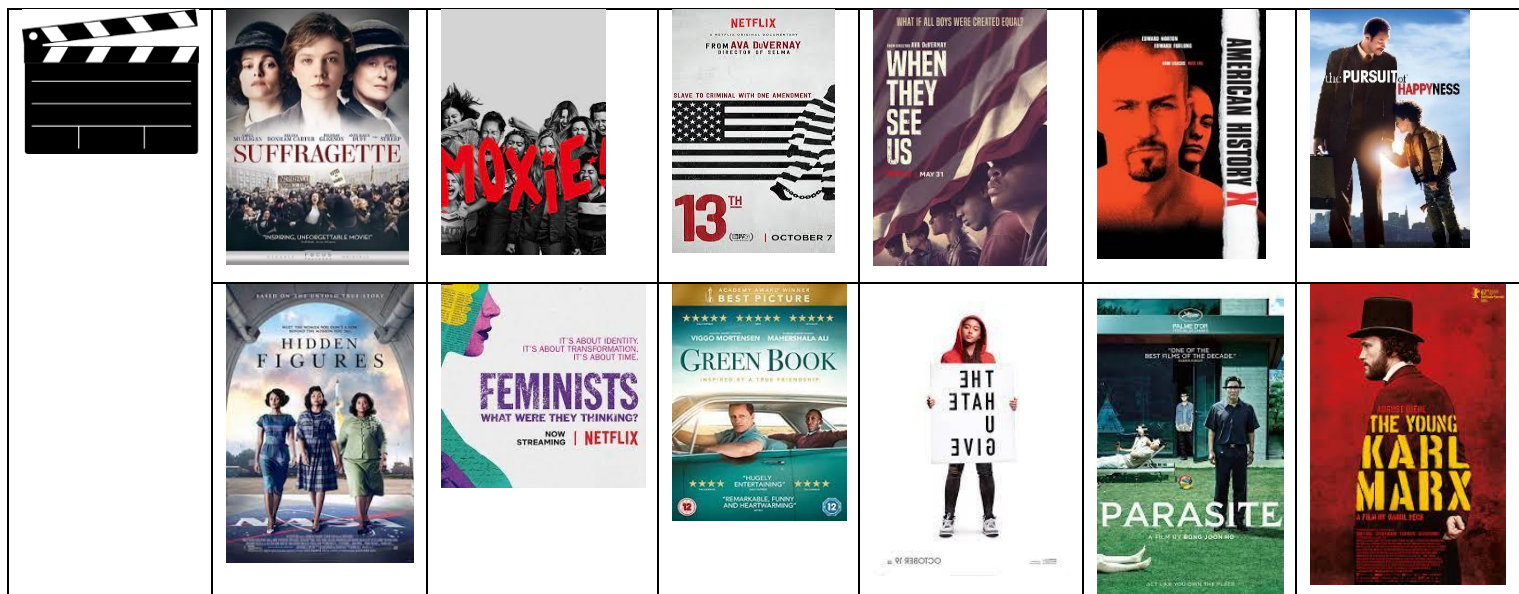
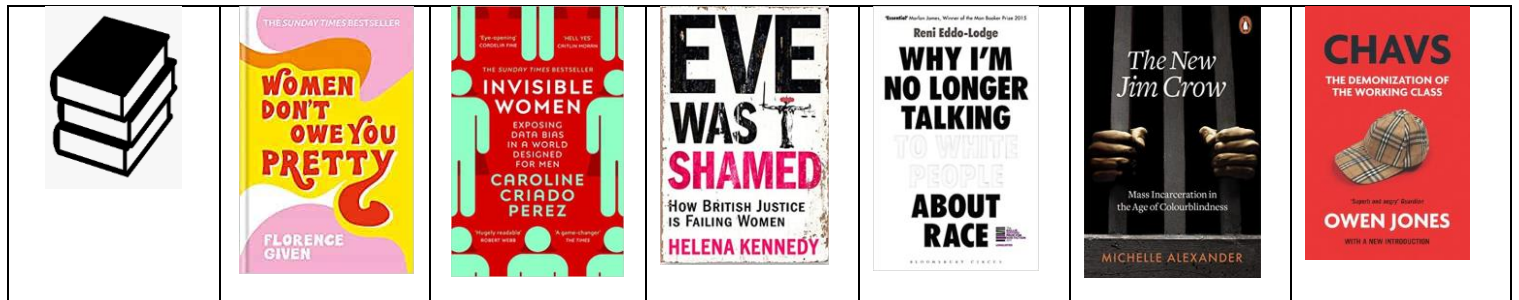


Sixth Form Enrolment Task ...Welcome to AQA Sociology!
